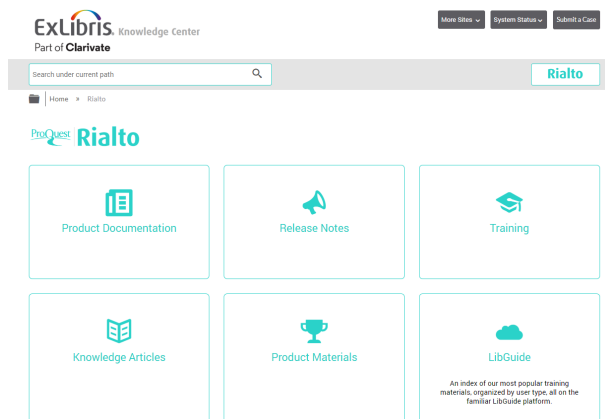

What's New in Rialto:

- **Real-Time Ebook Activation:** Libraries can provide rapid ebook access to their users with rapid fulfillment and real-time activation in Rialto. Through Rialto's partnership with several top ebook platforms, over 2 million ebooks can be fulfilled and activated in real-time via API, rather than waiting for MARC record loads. This means titles are discoverable for patrons within minutes, without manual intervention from the library.
- **Taylor & Francis EBA Pool Sync:** Institutions managing their Taylor & Francis Evidence-Based Acquisition programs on Rialto will benefit from more frequent pool synchronization. What's New in OASIS:

- **Near Real-Time Add to DDA:** OASIS will now send add-to-DDA requests for ebooks to our participating DDA platforms (EBC, EBSCO, JSTOR) every 15 minutes, ensuring patrons have more immediate access to titles on these platforms – without a 24 hour delay.
- **Ebook Central discount display in Search Results:** Ebook Central discounts will now display in the search results, allowing users to see the final price with discount at the search level before adding items to their cart.

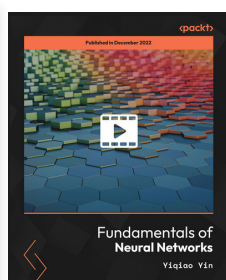
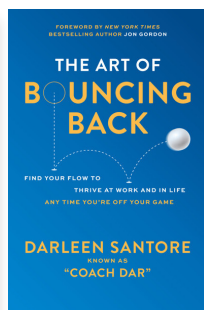
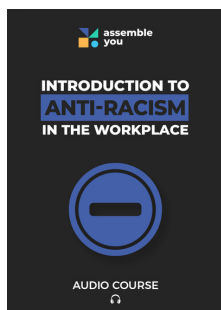
